1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction directing respondent Nos.1 to 5 to deliver the possession of the land measuring 14 kanals and 25 marlas situated in the revenue estate of Village Harsha Chhina, Tehsil Ajnala, District Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present Civil Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous as the land has been acquired and the petitioner has received the compensation and the petitioner has moved an application bearing No.CM-9240-CWP-2023

bringing out the facts which would show that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and has prayed that the main writ petition may kindly be disposed of as such.

3. Learned State Counsel has submitted that he has no objection in case, the application bearing No.CM-9240-CWP-2023 is allowed and the main writ petition is ordered to be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous
