The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to take action on his complaint dated 30.10.2022 (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no action on the representation has been taken despite sufficient period having been lapsed.
