ALOK JAIN, J. :

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.167 dated 28.07.2022, registered for offences under Sections 498-A, 323, 341, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1).

Vide order dated 26.08.2022, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

At this stage, learned counsel for the complainant has put in appearance and has submitted that the petitioner is in adultery and is now staying with another girl. However, there are no such allegations in the FIR.

In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 26.08.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
