The present petition has been filed for raising a challenge to the order dated 31.12.2013 & 03.01.2014 (Annexure P-10 & P-11 respectively) passed by Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar whereby the claim of the petitioner for seeking compassionate appointment has been rejected by the Deputy Commissioner on the ground that the same is not covered by the instructions of the government.

Written statement on behalf of the respondents had been filed on 15.01.2018 with copy to the counsel opposite wherein it was specifically averred that the policy of the State was applicable to the persons who are victims of terrorists violence. Inquiry into the allegations leveled by the petitioner had been conducted and that the incident in question was not an out come of terrorist incident but on account of some acts undertaken by the Robbers.

No replication controverting the aforesaid reply has been

filed during the period of 05 years when the matter is pending before this Court, further, it is also evident that the counsel for the petitioner has remained successively absent for last 05 dates in a row except for the hearing fixed on 06.12.2019 when a request for adjournment had been sought by him. Today also the position remained the same. It seems that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the present petition.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.
