1. This is the petitioner's 4th attempt, to get a bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.289, dated 21.11.2019, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station, Kalanwali, District Sirsa.
2. The learned counsel representing the State of Haryana has submitted that the prosecution evidence has already been led and the case is at the stage of defence evidence.
3. Thus, the trial of the case is at the fag end. Hence, it would not be appropriate to consider the request for grant of concession of bail particularly when the petitioner is also involved in another case registered under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.
4. Dismissed accordingly.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
