Instant petition has been preferred seeking quashing of the FIR (Annexure P-1), along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise effected between the parties on 13.07.2023 (Annexure P-2). Details of the FIR are as under: -

[2]. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide compromise deed dated 13.07.2023 (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

[3]. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, vide report dated 06.09.2023 has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

[4]. Respondent No. 2 is represented by his counsel and does not oppose the compromise.

[5]. In view of the aforesaid report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in “*Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another*”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and “*Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another*”, (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the respondent No. 2 has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioners.

[6]. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 0085 dated 16.06.2023, under Sections 323, 324, 451, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Nawanshahar, District SBS Nagar (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise dated 13.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) qua the present petitioners.
