This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 10.05.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab, order dated 25.05.2015 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Commissioner, Jalandhar, Division Jalandhar and order dated 10.05.2011 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Collector, Mukerian.

On 24.02.2020, coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner No.1 has passed away meanwhile and thus, his legal heirs have to be impleaded.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after complying with the order dated 24.02.2020 and after annexing all the above said orders and after giving better particulars.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
