At the outset, State counsel submits that the necessary relief as claimed in the present petition has been accorded to and the employees of District Rural Development Agencies (DRDAs) now stand merged and are now on the roles of Zila Parishad and Panchayat Samities under the reigns of Department of Panchayat.

2. On this, Mr. Goyal submits that though notification to that respect has been issued, however, the same does not take care of the employees serving with DRDAs, who have retired in the interregnum and prays for liberty to avail appropriate remedy w.r.t. the retired employees to claim retiral benefits including filing of fresh writ petition.

3. Prayer made is allowed. Writ stands disposed off.

- 4. Ordered accordingly.
- 5. Since the main case has been decided, pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed off.
