1. This is second petition filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 199, dated 6.10.2020, under Sections 22 and 25 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the Act') registered at Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar, Punjab.

2. The main thrust for seeking regular bail is on the ground of custody period.

3. The prayer is being opposed by learned State counsel. He on instructions submits that out of total thirty two witnesses, five witnesses have been examined and an earnest effort would be made to examine the remaining prosecution witnesses within six months from the date fixed in the trial Court.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn.

6. There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the court concerned for accommodating the date for examining the prosecution witnesses, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
