1. Reply filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 is taken on record.

Copy thereof, has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

2. In para 4 of the reply, it is stated that the matter in respect of payment of arrears of 7th Pay Commission for the period of 01.01.2016 to 31.12.2019 in the shape of grant-in-aid has been submitted before the competent authority and which is under consideration. It is further stated that as soon as the said matter is decided, the necessary action will be taken, accordingly.

3. In view of the afore-said stand taken by respondents No.1 and 2, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may be disposed of, however, she submits that a direction be issued to respondents to release the arrears in a time bound manner.
