The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners as vide order dated 12.05.2023, the learned Appellate Court had cancelled the bail granted to the petitioners and their bail bonds and surety bonds were ordered to be forfeited to the State and they were ordered to be summoned through non-bailable warrants.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the petitioners have appeared before the Court of Mr. Avtar Singh, learned Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar and have been admitted to interim bail.

In view of the above-stated fact, the learned State counsel is not in a position to controvert the factual submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 01.08.2023 is made absolute. The petitioners shall be

admitted to bail subject to the furnishing of surety bonds/bail bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate.

The petitioners shall continue to appear before the learned trial Court on each and every date of hearing and shall not absent during the course of proceedings without prior permission of the Court.
