The petitioners herein have sought the relief of pre-arrest/anticipatory bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.101 dated 17.07.2022 as registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka, under Sections 498A, 406 & 506 IPC and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Balkar Singh from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 27.03.2023, both the petitioners have joined in the investigation and their custodial

interrogation is not required and they are also not involved in any other criminal case.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as already extended to the petitioners by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 27.03.2023, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions, as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
