This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction restraining the respondents to continue with the charge sheet dated 21.06.2021 (Annexure P-2) against the petitioner during the pendency of criminal trial in FIR no.004 dated 18.06.2021 (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, criminal proceedings have finished and the petitioner has been acquitted by being given the benefit of doubt and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of and liberty be granted to the petitioner to bring the said factum to the notice of the authorities.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. It would be open to the petitioner to bring the judgment of acquittal to the notice to be authorities and the authorities would consider the same and proceed, in accordance with law.
4. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and it would be open to all the parties to raise all please before the competent authority.
