Present petition has been moved under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the impugned order dated 15.04.2023 (Annexure P-4) as well as order dated 29.05.2023 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana in case NDPS/13519/2018 titled 'State Vs. Ganesh Dutt and another' in FIR No. 95 dated 10.05.2018 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Samrala, District Khanna.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioner had surrendered before the trial Court on 16.08.2023 in compliance with the order dated 09.08.2023 passed by this Court.

3. Learned State counsel has also admitted that the petitioner had surrendered before the trial Court on 16.08.2023.

4. After hearing respective contentions and taking into consideration the fact that in compliance with the order dated 09.08.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already appeared before the learned trial Court on 16.08.2023, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide

order dated 09.08.2023 is hereby confirmed with a direction to the petitioner to regularly appear before the concerned Court on each and every date; not to tamper with evidence of prosecution in any manner; not to leave the country without prior permission of the Court; and as a consequent the impugned orders dated 15.04.2023 (Annexure P-4) and 29.05.2023 (Annexure P-5) respectively passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana are hereby set aside.
