The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of complaint No.1210 dated 04.03.2016 (Annexure P-9) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom as well as the impugned order dated 09.04.2018 (Annexure P-25) including the interim order dated 13.12.2016 (Annexure P-17) and interim order dated 13.09.2017 (Annexure P-23).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that on account of amendment in the Act, the present petition has been rendered infructuous. He contends that liberty, however, be granted to the petitioners to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to the petitioners in accordance with law in the event of any fresh grievance.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberties as aforesaid.
