1. The petitioner by way of this Writ Petition has prayed for setting aside order dated 20.10.2015 passed by respondent No.2 whereby the claim raised by the petitioner for consideration of her marks of qualification of B.Ed. as per the criteria for promotion for the post of Anganwari Worker to Supervisor in the BC category.
2. As per the scheme relating to Anganwari workers, appeal against orders of which any person is aggrieved of relating to appointment of Anganwari workers lies to the Collector, then to the Commissioner, and then to the Secretary.
3. In view thereof, having efficacious alternative remedy, this Writ Petition is ***dismissed*** granting liberty to the petitioner to avail alternative remedy.
4. If such an appeal is preferred, the same shall be decided, after giving opportunity of hearing to all the parties, within a period of ***four months***.
5. All pending applications filed in this Writ Petition shall stand disposed of.
