**AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)**

1. This petition is filed praying for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 337 dated 14.07.2022 registered under Sections 22C/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Dabua, District Faridabad.
2. The brief facts are that the police party on 14.07.2022, on the basis of a secret information apprehended Happy @ Harpreet and from a polythene carried by him, 12 injections of Buprenorphine (2 ml each) were recovered. The petitioner was named by the co-accused as supplier of the recovered contraband.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the main accused was granted default bail by this Court. He further submits that the petitioner was named in the disclosure statement and no recovery was made from him.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Chandershekhar, opposes the prayer on the ground that the petitioner is involved in one more case under NDPS.
5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering that the name of the petitioner surfaced in disclosure statement; no recovery was made from him; main accused has already been granted the default bail, the petitioner is granted bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
6. The petition is allowed.
7. Since the main case has been allowed, pending application, if any, is rendered infructuous.
