DEEPAK GUPTA, J.(Oral)

Petitioner is praying for regular bail in case FIR No.456, dated 24.03.2023, registered at Police Station Panipat City, District Panipat, under Sections 120-B, 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he identified a fake surety, in another case before the Trial Court.

It is contended by learned counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated; that he is in custody for the last more than 4 months and trial is likely to take time to conclude, so he be allowed bail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vipul Sherwal, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner in this case is in custody since 24.03.2023. It is also informed that challan has already been presented in the Court; and that charges are yet to be framed.

The case is triable by the Magistrate. The petitioner is in custody for the last 04 months and 10 days. The trial is likely to take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served to detain the petitioner in custody.

Having regard to the aforesaid factual position, but without commenting anything upon the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
