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This is an application to place on record copy of order dated 19.01.2023 passed by this Court in connected CRM-M-40784 of 2022 titled "Bhajan Singh Vs. State of Haryana and another", as Annexure A.1.

Application is allowed. Annexure A.1 is taken on record.

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By way of this petition, prayer is made to quash FIR No.0153 dated 20.11.2020 registered under Sections 323, 325, 34, 452, 506 IPC at Police Station Panjokhra, District Ambala and all the subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 18.08.2022.

On 16.11.2022, the following order was passed by this Court:-

"The petitioners through instant petition, on the basis of compromise/Affidavit dated 18.8.2022 (Annexures P-2 and P-

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3) are seeking quashing of FIR No.153 dated 20.11.2020, under Sections 323, 325, 34, 452 and 506 of IPC registered at Police Station Panjokhra, District Ambala and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for private respondent submits that the parties have already appeared before the trial court in FIR No. 22 dated 27.1.2022, under Sections 406 and 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station Panjokhara, District Ambala. He further submits that in the present FIR, parties are same and they have entered into a compromise, thus, there is no need to tender statements before trial court in the present FIR. CRM-M- 40784 of 2022 arising out of FIR No. 22 dated 27.1.2022 is pending consideration before Court for 19.1.2023.

Adjourned to 19.1.2023.

To be heard along with CRM-M- 40784 of 2022.”

Today, learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record Annexure P.1, which is the copy of the order dated 19.01.2023 passed by this Court in CRM-M-40784 of 2022, which reveals that FIR No.22 dated 27.01.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at Police Station Panjokhara, District Ambala has already been quashed, on the basis of compromise dated 18.08.2022 (Annexure P.2).

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 – complainant, present in Court, admits the factum of compromise dated 18.08.2022 (Annexure P.2).

In view of the statements recorded in CRM-M-40784 of 2022, FIR No.0153 dated 20.11.2020 registered under Sections 323, 325, 34, 452, 506 IPC at Police Station Panjokhra, District Ambala and all the subsequent

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proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 18.08.2022, are quashed.
