The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0042 dated 05.02.2021 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Tosham, District Bhiwani, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 11.10.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Satpal Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

Since, the registration certificates of the truck sought to be recovered can be easily obtained from the Transport Department, no case for the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is made out.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 11.10.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
