ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend danger from the private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have performed their marriage, which is against the wishes of private respondents and they have apprehension that the private respondents might cause physical harm to them.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has drawn my attention to the representation dated 27.07.2023 (Annexure P-5) sent by the petitioners to respondent No. 2 –Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga.

4. Issue notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Shubham Kaushik, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

5. Respondent No.5-Manju and respondent No.8-Surinder, who are present in person, submit that they want to meet petitioner No.1 and a meeting may kindly be arranged.
6. Heard. Keeping in view the mandate of the Supreme Court in the case of “**Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another**”, JT 2006 (6) SC 173, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents. He shall also arrange a meeting of petitioner No.1 with the private respondents.
7. It is clarified that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion with regard to the validity of the marriage has been expressed in this order. This order shall not protect the petitioners from any legal proceedings instituted against them in accordance with law.
8. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
