The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the quashing of the order dated 15.01.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by the JMIC, Jalandhar vide which the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender in private complaint Case No.COMI/32054/2013 dated 07.02.2013 (Annexure P-2) under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 326, 506, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Bhogpur along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

A reply dated 06.07.2023 by way of an affidavit of Sukhnaaz Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Adampur, Jalandhar (Rural) has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner faced trial and has been acquitted vide judgment dated 10.07.2023.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
