VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the impugned order dated 27.07.2023 (Annexure P-18) vide which regularization orders of the petitioners issued vide order dated 21.05.2022 have been withdrawn.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioners no.1 to 3 had previously filed a writ petition i.e., CWP-24505-2014, which was allowed by a coordinate Bench of this Court with a direction to the respondents to consider the cases of the petitioners for regularization in the first available policy after they had completed 10 years of service from the initial date of their respective appointments, within a period of two months from the date of receiving the certified copy of the said order. It is further submitted that a Letters Patent Appeal against the

said order has been filed and no stay has been granted in the same. It is stated that in pursuance of the said order passed by the learned Single Judge, petitioners no.1 to 3 and other petitioners were regularized and the said order has been withdrawn on 27.07.2023. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a contempt petition and also to pursue alternative remedy, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
