The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to decide the representation dated 19.04.2023 (Annexure P-4)

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that FIR No.8 dated 20.01.2021 under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act registered at Police Station Model Town Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) was got registered by the petitioner way back in the year 2020-21 and thereafter the accused mentioned therein are time and again extending threats to the petitioner. She further submits that she had moved various representations to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana and to the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Punjab but no action thereon has been taken.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Swati Batra, DAG, Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, without commenting on the merits of the petition, the petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-4) dated 19.04.2023 expeditiously in accordance with law. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner as well.

6. It is however, made clear that any observation made above shall not affect the merits of the case nor the same will influence the concerned authority in deciding the representation in accordance with law.
