Challenge in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the possession notice dated 17.06.2022 (Annexure P-2) issued under Section 13 (4) of the Securitization and Re-construction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002.

A perusal of the said possession notice would go on to show that a sum of ₹1,63,90,663.77 was due as on 30.04.2021 and symbolic possession has been taken.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Even on 15.11.2022 none had put in appearance.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
