**VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)**

This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing and striking down the proceedings against the petitioner, emanating and including the impugned summons dated 06.03.2017 issued by respondent no.3 and quashing of impugned recovery certificate dated 21.09.2015. Other prayers have also been made in the petition.

As per the report of the Registry, notice could not be issued to respondent no.2 for want of process fee. On 29.10.2018 it was noted by the coordinate Bench of this Court that notice could not be issued to respondent no.2 as the counsel for the petitioner had not filed the process fee and as such fresh notice was ordered to be issued on filing process fee. Thereafter on 10.09.2019, a coordinate Bench of this Court had noticed that as per the report of the Registry, notice could not be issued to respondent no.2 for

want of process fee and again fresh notice was ordered to be issued on deposit of process fee within a period of three days from 10.09.2019. Even now as per the report of the Registry, process fee has not been filed. No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.

It would be open to the petitioner to move an application for restoration in case any cause survives.
