SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail in FIR No.14, dated 08.01.2017, registered at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad, under Sections 302 & 307 IPC read with Section 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody in excess of six years. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as 12 Pws remain to be examined.

Custody certificate dated 07.02.2023 checked by Sh. Vikram Singh, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail No.2, Hisar has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record. A perusal thereof shows that the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 06 years and 28 days and there is no other criminal case pending against him. Two convictions have been recorded in one of which, he has undergone the sentence and in the other, his remaining sentence has been suspended.

Learned State counsel admits that 12 Pws remain to be examined.

In view of the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as well as the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for 06 years and 28 days, I deem it appropriate to grant him regular bail. Accordingly, the petition is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
