The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.51 dated 02.06.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Division No.1, Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 31.08.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.
