Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 5 to take action on the complaints made by the petitioner against respondent No.6 for indulging in the illegal activities in the functioning and works of the Gram Panchayat village Sachander, Block Verka, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that despite representation dated 03.04.2023 (Annexure P-6) filed by the petitioner to the DDPO, Amritsar, no action has been taken on the same till date.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Akshita Chauhan, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. On instructions, she has submitted that the petitioner filed similar representation and thereafter he withdrew the same in the month of February 2023 being satisfied with the work done by the respondent-Sarpanch.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that thereafter, the petitioner filed another complaint/representation dated 03.04.2023 and in the same summons have also been issued to the Sarpanh, but he is not appearing before the authorities.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, it is apparent that on the fresh representation/complaint filed by the petitioner, respondent-authorities have already initiated the process as admittedly summons have been issued to the respondent-Sarpanch. In view of the same, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to proceed with the matter in accordance with law.
