Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 30.09.2021 (Annexure P-3) vide which the petitioner has been ordered to be retired at the age of 58 years.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that during pendency of the petition, petitioner has attained the age of 60 years.

In view of the above, writ petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.

However, in case, any grievance still survives, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move a representation before the competent authority, who will look into it and pass an appropriate order within a period of four

months from the date of receipt of representation.
