orderd as passed in CRM-M-34079-2022 in order dated 10.08.2022, whereby
respondent-State was directed not to take any coercive steps against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Karnail Singh,
submits that though the specific directions were not issued for the petitioner to
join the investigation, still petitioner on his own, appeared before the Investigating
Officer and was associated in the investigation and is not required for custodial
interrogation.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is not required for custodial
interrogation, therefore, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition.

Hence, the same is hereby disposed of, as such.
