The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* seeking quashing of the show cause notice dated 26.10.2017 (Annexure P-20) as well as order dated 10.11.2017 (Annexure P-24) passed by respondent No.1 during the pendency of writ petition, wherein petitioner was repatriated to the post of clerk in Haryana Slum Clearance Board (HSCB) with further a prayer to quash the impugned order dated 24.11.2016 (Annexure P-7), show cause notice dated 07.12.2016 (Annexure P-9) and chargesheet dated 02.01.2017 (Annexure P-11) as well as order dated 18.10.2017 (Annexure P-18).

Today, Ms. Dimple Jain, DAG Haryana has produced a copy of the order dated 08.03.2022 informing the Court that the order dated 10.11.2017 (Annexure P-24) has been cancelled and, therefore, no grievance is left in the instant petition.

A copy of order has been furnished to the counsel for the petitioner, who is also satisfied to the statement made by Ms. Dimple Jain.

In the light of above, this Court is duly convinced that this petition does not survive any more, as having been rendered infructuous.
