1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438
Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
142	30.05.2023	Patran, District Patiala	420, 468, 471, 120-B IPC

2. On the basis of status report filed by way of affidavit
of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Patran, District Patiala

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and upon instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh, State counsel submits that all 42 SIMs allegedly sold by the petitioner on fake documents have been deactivated and POS Dealership of the petitioner has been suspended by the Telecom Company. Upon categoric instructions, State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation. He has specific instructions to state that petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

3. In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the allegations, petition is allowed. Order dated 04.10.2023 is made absolute, subject to satisfaction of conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
