HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner was working in the office of Zila Parishad, Kaithal against the post of Peon, which post is still lying vacant and the respondents can duly re-engage the petitioner on the same post as the work of the said post still exist to be performed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intends to make a representation with the respondents for the said prayer and the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents, on the instructions from Mr. Ashwani Malik, CEO, Zila Parishad, Kaithal, submits that in case any post of Peon is lying vacant in the office of Zila Parishad, Kaithal and the work of the said post still exists and in case, any representation is made by

the petitioner for re-engagement, due consideration will be given to the said claim and appropriate order will be passed and in case after the passing of the speaking order, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to him.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents be bound to decide the said claim in a time bound manner.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that any claim raised will be decided within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such claim.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate representation with the respondents.

7. Ordered accordingly.
