[1] Appeal is of the year 2009.

[2] On 28.08.2019, on request of counsel for the appellants, the case was adjourned to 09.04.2020, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with the State Legal Service Authority, Punjab, while noticing that the adjournment would be the third opportunity to learned counsel for the appellants to address arguments, inasmuch as, earlier also on 04.07.2016 and 22.05.2017, last opportunity had been granted to learned counsel for the appellants.

[3] Learned counsel for the appellants was also directed to produce original receipt with regard to deposit of costs on the date fixed, failing which the appeal would entail dismissal for want of prosecution, while making it clear that no further adjournment would be granted. Thereafter, due to pandemic, the matter could not be listed and came to be taken up and listed for hearing only on 06.07.2022 on which date, again

none appeared on behalf of the appellants. In the circumstances, while keeping in view the fact that the appeal had been listed almost after three years, the case was adjourned to 21.10.2022, while affording one more opportunity to learned counsel for the appellants to address arguments, subject to compliance of order dated 28.08.2019. Thereafter, on 21.10.2022, the matter was adjourned by order to 25.04.2023.

[4] Today, none is present on behalf of the appellants, while as per office noting dated 21.04.2023, receipt of costs in compliance of order dated 28.08.2019 and 06.07.2022 has not been furnished.

[5] *Dismissed for non prosecution.*
