The petitioner prays for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the result of physical test conducted for the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police qua him.

Pursuant to the recruitment notice No.14 of 2020, the petitioner wrote the preliminary examination as well as the mains examination. The petitioner was called for attending the physical test on 16.06.2021. The petitioner claims that he was diagnosed positive for Corona virus infection on 20.05.2021 and was quarantined upto 05.06.2021. The petitioner attended the physical test held on 16.06.2021, however, he was unable to run as per the medical advice given to him. It is evident that the selection process has already been completed. The petitioner has not impleaded any of the selected candidate. At this stage, he cannot, as a matter of right, claim that the physical test qua him should be held once again.

Hence, no ground to issue the writ as prayed for, is made out.

Dismissed.
