The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order dated 14.02.2013 passed by the respondent No.2 pursuant to the directions of the Court in his previously filed writ petition. It has been observed in the order that despite public notice published in the newspapers on 28.06.2011 and 29.06.2011, the petitioner did not attend the counselling along with the original documents on 10.07.2011, the date fixed for counselling to the post of vocational master on contractual basis.

2 Some relevant facts are required to be noticed, which are as follows:-

The petitioner had applied pursuant to a recruitment notice issued on 23.09.2009 inviting applications for recruitment to the post of vocational master in the various subjects including computer science. A provisional merit list was prepared and published. The petitioner's name figured at serial No.36 amongst the candidates belonging to the backward classes. After the first counselling, the second counselling was held on

10.07.2011 after giving public notice inviting candidates to come for the scrutiny of documents on 10.07.2011. The respondents while filing the additional affidavit dated 20.03.2020 have also attached a copy of the attendance sheet, wherein, the petitioner's name has been figured at serial No.36 and he has been marked absent.

3. The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that certain candidates have been wrongly selected. It is not in dispute that the alleged wrongly selected candidates have not been impleaded as a party.

4. In view of the aforesaid, no ground to issue the writ as prayed for by the petitioner, is made out.

5. Dismissed.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
