This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 09.08.2022 (Annexure P-8).

On 03.02.2023, this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Learned counsel for respondent Nos.6 to 9 has pointed out that the present Civil Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous as the Administrator was appointed for a period of 60 days and the said period has elapsed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in rebuttal, has submitted that the stay was granted to the petitioner on 02.09.2022 by the Coordinate Bench of this Court.

Learned State Counsel is directed to get instructions as to whether, in case, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, then, the Administrator would take over or not and is also directed to file a short affidavit on the said aspect.
