Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to relax the age criteria in the case of the petitioner for applying for the post of Animal Attendant as per advertisement dated 26.08.2018, Annexure P-8, as the petitioner has already been working on the said post in the same department on contract basis, having been duly selected pursuant to advertisement dated 22.06.2016, Annexure P-4, and meeting the age/eligibility criteria at the time of advertisement, Annexure P-4.
