1. The petitioner Kannan Shiv Kumar has filed petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram for expeditious disposal of case bearing HMA/680/2022 dated 18.05.2022 titled as “Kannan Shiv Kumar Vs. Anubhuti Bhasin” filed under Section 12 (1) (B) & (C) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 read with Section 7 (1) (B) (A) of Family Courts Act, 1984 for nullity of marriage in a time bound manner.

2. For the disposal of the civil revision, status report has been received from the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram. Perusal of status report shows that the petition was filed in the year 2022 in which notice was given to the respondent who did not appear and was proceeded against ex-parte. The ex-parte evidence was also recorded. Thereafter, on 26.04.2023 the respondent appeared in person along with counsel and sought adjournment to file application for setting aside ex-

parte order 24.08.2022 and the case was again adjourned for 13.07.2023. On this date, the case was adjourned for 14.08.2023 for arguments. On this date, the Presiding Officer was on leave and it was taken up on 10.08.2023 and it was further adjourned for 21.11.2023. The perusal of status report indicates that the petition was filed in the year 2022 and the Presiding Officer is proceeding in this case as per law. The case does not come even in the category of old cases. Considering these facts, I do not find any necessity to pass any directions.

3. The Civil Revision is accordingly declined.
