1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to issue him passport.

2. The petitioner was issued passport No. F8354482 on 09.06.2006 which was valid upto 08.06.2016. Four FIRs came to be registered against the petitioner. The petitioner was acquitted in FIR No.140 dated 30.06.2016. The police filed cancellation report in FIR No.120/2007 and FIR No. 114/2015. The police has presented challan in FIR No.51/2018, however, petitioner has not been named in the Challan.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that case of the petitioner is squarely covered by judgment of this Court in ***Mohan Lal @***

Mohna vs. Union of India and others 2023 SCC Online P&H 1391.

4. Learned State counsel confirms the aforesaid factual position with respect to above-mentioned FIRs.
5. Faced with this, learned counsel for the respondents- UOI submits that application of the petitioner shall be processed within 6 weeks after considering judgment of this Court in *Mohan Lal @ Mohna* (supra).
6. In the wake of statements of both sides, the petition stands disposed of.
