1. By this common order, two writ petitions, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being decided as both these petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

2. In the present petitions, the grievance of the petitioners is that they are entitled for the grant of leave encashment in respect of service rendered by Krishna Devi and Shakuntla along with interest.

3. Separate affidavit of the respective Officer-cum-Block Development and Panchayat Officer dated 27.09.2023 in both the petitions has been filed in Court today, wherein, it has been mentioned that the benefit of leave encashment amounting to Rs. 1,50,750/- in favour of Smt. Shakuntla has already been paid to her through RTGS on 25.09.2023 and in case of Krishna Devi, an amount of Rs. 2,45,990/- has already been deposited in the account of her son through RTGS on 25.09.2023.

4. That being the factual aspect, *prima-facie*, the claim of the petitioners stands satisfied. Further, in case the petitioners still have any grievance, the same can be raised by way of representation before the respondents and in case, any such claim is raised by the petitioners, the respondents are directed to decide the said claim within a period of eight weeks of receiving any such representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

5. Petitions are disposed of in above terms.
