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**VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)**

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 25.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.4 whereby husband of the petitioner has been dismissed from the service.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed an appeal (Annexure P-5) against the order of dismissal from service of her husband dated 25.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) and she would be satisfied at this stage, in case, respondent No.2-Director General of Police is directed to decide the same as expeditiously as possible.

3. Learned State Counsel has submitted that every endeavour

would be made by respondent No.2 to decide the appeal as expeditiously as possible.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the appeal (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioner as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

5. This Court has not opined on the merits of the case and it would be open to respondent No.2 to decide the case of the petitioner independently and in accordance with law.
