The petitioner has sought quashing of the proceedings concluded on 06.07.2015 carried out under Section 51 (7) (C) of the Punjab VAT Act, 2005, imposing penalty of Rs.2,34,638/-.

As per order dated 04.10.2017, the petitioner has deposited Rs.5 Lakhs in the name of Registrar General of this Court to show its *bonafide* with respect to the allegations made in the petition.

A perusal of the order dated 12.02.2020 passed by this Court shows that during the pendency of this petition, various developments have taken place and both the parties had filed misc. applications, due to which, the record of this petition became large and unmanageable. A direction was given to the petitioner to file amended writ petition, so that detailed written statement could be filed by the respondents, for a proper decision of this

case.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that he does not want to file the amended petition and seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, Rs.5 Lakhs deposited by the petitioner with the Registrar of this Court, be returned to him.
