Learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondent are ad idem that the petition be disposed of with a direction to the Appellate Court to consider and decide the appeal expeditiously and till the pendency of the appeal, the mesne profits of Rs.1500/- per month as ordered by this Court on 22.08.2019 be paid to the respondent-landlord.

Heard.

The appeal against the eviction order of the Rent Controller is stated to have been filed on 27.03.2019 and, therefore, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Appellate Court to consider and decide the appeal expeditiously preferably within a period of three months.

Till the appeal is decided, the mesne profits of Rs.1500/- per month as ordered by this Court on 22.08.2019 would be payable to the respondent-landlord. The arrears of mesne profits shall also be paid within a period of one month from now.
