It is, *inter alia*, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that feeling aggrieved by the acts of respondents No. 4 to 6, the petitioner had moved a representation dated 13.05.2023 (Annexure P-8) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, S.B.S. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if the directions are issued to respondent No. 2- Senior Superintendent of Police, SBS Nagar, to consider and decide the representation dated 13.05.2023 (Annexure P-8) in an expeditious manner.
