1. Since it is stated at the bar, by the learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions imparted to him, that the auction proceedings are over, therefore, the writ petition for cancellation, and, rescinding of the relevant auction becomes redundant infructuous, and, is dismissed as such.
2. Be that as it may, if any observations in respect of any illegality being made in the auction proceedings, thus are made in the order rescinding the auction, thereupon the respondents concerned, may proceed to in accordance with law, draw lawful action against the derelicting officer concerned.
