The petitioners have filed the instant petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.52 dated 19.04.2023 registered under Sections 336 (added later on), 341, 427, 148, 149 of IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act (Sections 307, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act deleted) at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 03.08.2023, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.
