Both these petitions are being disposed by a common order since the dispute involved is same. For the facility of reference, the facts are being extracted from CWP-19611-2022 titled as “Baljinder Kaur versus State of Punjab and others”.

The petitioner(s) have approached this Court for seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to issue a Police Clearance Certificate.

CWP-19611-2022 & CWP-19637-2022

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It has been averred in the petition that Gurinder Singh, son of the petitioner is having an Indian Passport No. U6992651 dated 12.02.2020 valid upto 11.02.2030. He had applied for VISA to Canada which was issued and is valid till 06.10.2023 alongwith work permit. It is contended that a Police Clearance Certificate was accordingly required. An application in this regard was submitted by the petitioner vide receipt No. 114935 on 01.08.2022 alongwith requisite fee deposit.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh submits that in the event of a fresh application for issuance of 'Police Clearance Certificate' being submitted by the petitioner, the same shall be issued in accordance with law without any further delay and within a period of one month of submission of such application.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by the State counsel on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, Counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

Disposed of as not pressed.

Needless to mention that the respondent-State shall remain bound by the statement made today in the Court.
