The petitioner prays for issuance of an appropriate writ to quash the action of the respondents in not granting promotion to the petitioner to the post of Assistant Director, Horticulture. This writ petition was taken up for hearing with **CWP-25486-2015 titled as “Om Parkash Vs. State of Punjab and others”**.

On 24.08.2022, in CWP-25486-2015, the following order was passed:-

“A perusal of paragraph of preliminary objection No. 2 reveals that after consideration of the matter, category of the petitioner has been rectified from BC to SC, vide order dated 20.05.2016 (Annexure R-1).

Concededly petitioner stands at serial no. 182 and the junior person namely, Swaran Singh who is at No. 198 has already been promoted to the post of Assistant Director Horticulture while passing the order dated 18.11.2015 (Annexure P-7).

In view of the above factual position, respondents No. 2 will consider the claim of the petitioner as per law for the aforesaid post within a period of four weeks, if he is otherwise eligible.

Needful be done before the date fixed. ”

Pursuant to the directions of the Court in CWP-25486-2015, the

Secretary, Horticulture has passed an order on 11.01.2023. The learned

counsel representing the respondent submits that the petitioner's case for promotion shall also be considered within a period of one month.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of with a request to the Secretary, Horticulture, Government of Punjab, to pass a fresh order after considering the claim of the writ petitioner- Sh.Paramjit Singh son of Sh. Ajmer Singh.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
